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## Frames - Charts

There are, of course, many ways to represent data. A chart displays historical data for an issue in graphic format:

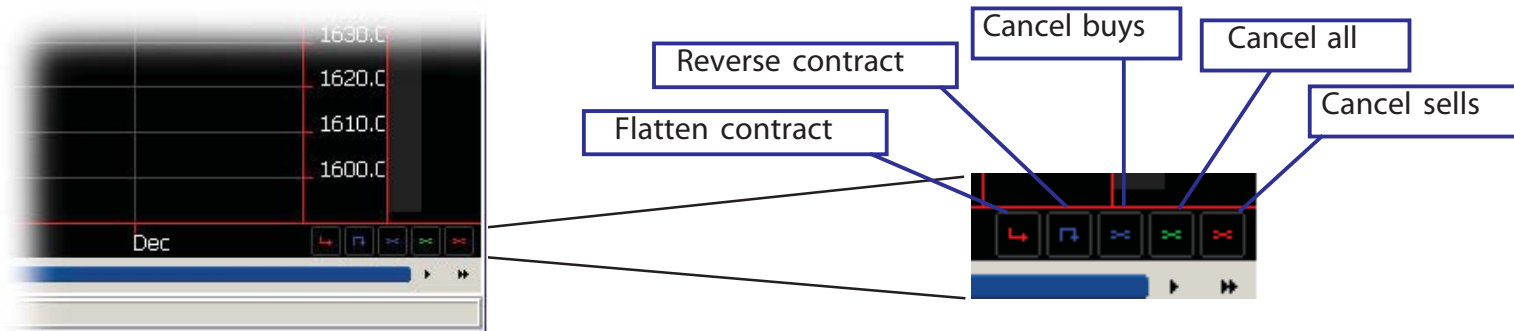


### Actions for this window:

- Press the left mouse button while on the chart to see the value and the timestamp of the point where the mouse pointer is. *Eg.: value: 1363.30, Timestamp 12/12/2006 3:22:34 PM.* In the info box, information about the evolution of the contract will be displayed at the mouse pointer position as well.
- Positioning the mouse to the right of the value scale (see blue box above), you can **left-click buy / right-click sell** to place an order at the price corresponding to the mouse pointer position.
- Turn the mouse wheel over the values scale to zoom in or zoom out the values on the values scale.
- Turn the mouse wheel over the time scale to zoom in or zoom out the time on the time scale.
- Navigate through the chart by **1.)** pressing the arrow keys on the keyboard, or **2.)** (top to bottom) keeping the left mouse button pressed and moving up and down over the values scale / (right to left) keeping the left mouse button pressed and moving the blue scroll bar across the bottom.

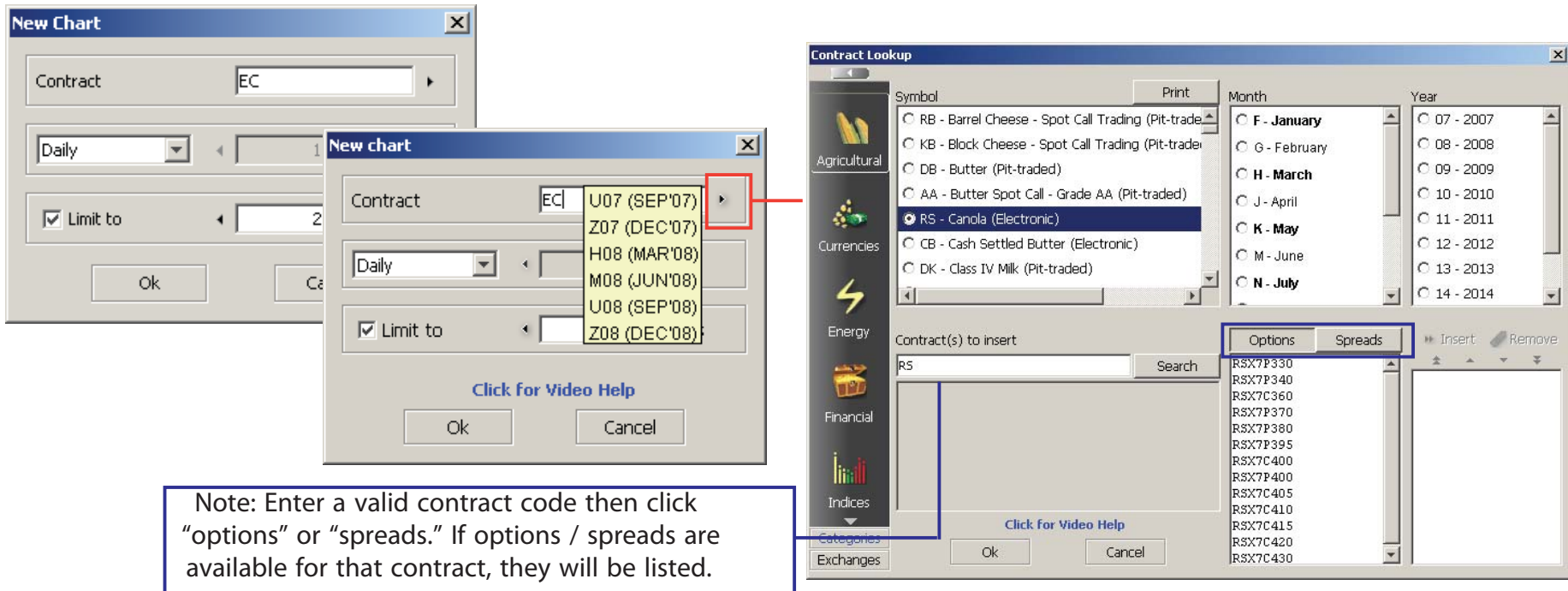
## Canceling orders:

From the chart, you can flatten the contract at the market price, reverse the contract, cancel the buy orders for the contract, cancel all the orders for the contract or cancel the sell orders for the contract. The buttons are in the lower right part of the frame.



## New Contract:

If you start typing the symbol of a contract, a date pull down menu appears. And if you click on the arrow pointing right, a full contract lookup window appears. The lookup can access agricultural contracts, currency, energy, financial, indices, metals, and weather contracts.



## The Right Click:

With the mouse positioned on any blank area within the chart, right-clicking will open up a menu containing many options. You can change the chart to line, area, bar, or candle (discussed later), or access chart modifiers, chart tools (Fibonacci fans and arcs, for example). In this case, we have selected “switch mode,” which causes an informational window displaying the contract highs, lows, and net change for the day.

## Charts - the 4 types

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There are four types of chart data representation - line, area, bars, candles:

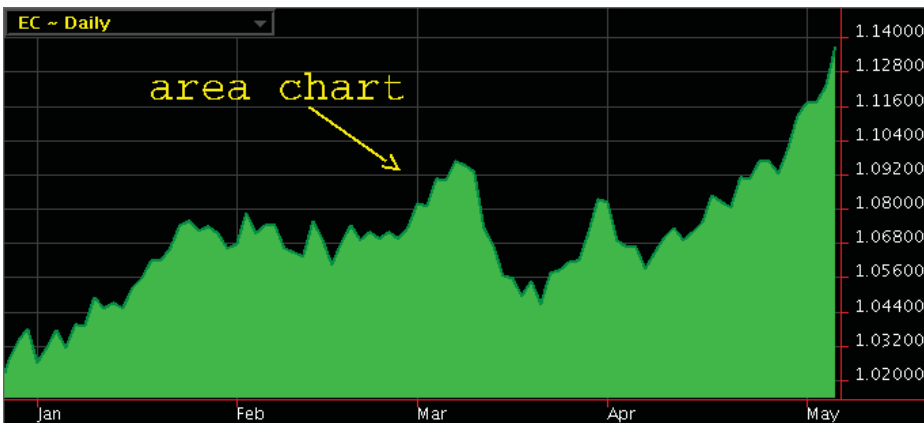
### Line Chart

A line chart is the simplest chart type. It is created by drawing lines from one price to another during a time period. The prices used for the line chart are: close, low, high and open price. By default the price used is close. You can change it in the "Lines Properties" dialog, found by double clicking on the status bar - "Lines" section.



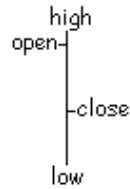
### Area Chart

Area chart is similar with line chart, the difference being that the area chart is filled.



## Bar Chart

A bar chart shows more data than a line chart. The open, high, low and close price for a chart point are shown all at the same time on a bar chart.



When a chart point is created, the first line that is drawn is open price. Then the price is oscillating from one price to another, this will give the high and the low price for the chart point. The final price for the chart point is close price.

When you click the left mouse button, the bar at the same timestamp as the mouse pointer will be highlighted as in the example below. The same feature is available with the Candles Chart.



## Candles Chart

A candle chart shows the same information as a bar chart: open, low, high and close price. In plus, the change in price is more evident on this type of chart because the difference between the open and close is shown graphically. In the following example, the  $O < C$  color is white and the  $O > C$  color is red. The color of candles can be changed from the preferences dialog



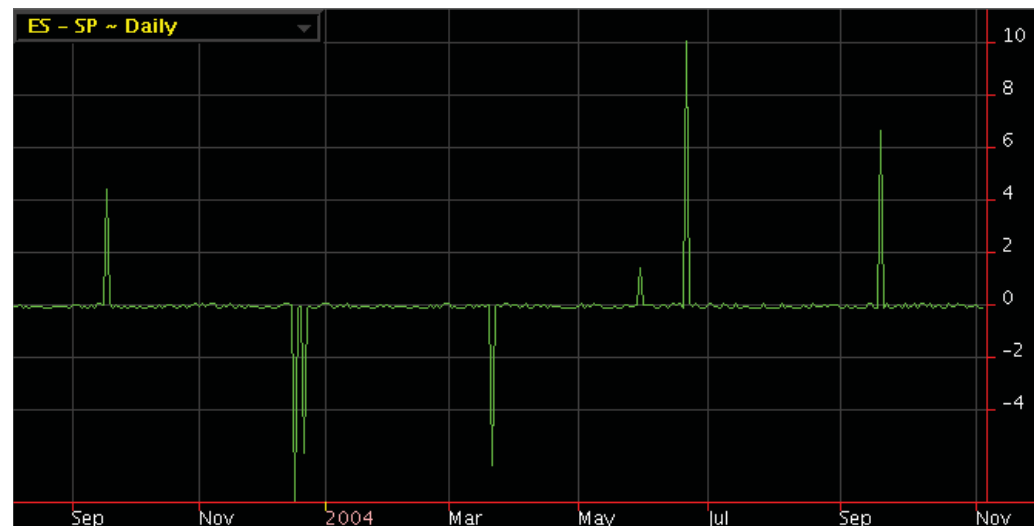
## Spread Charts

Spread Charts help you to watch over the evolution of a contract in comparison with another contract. A simple spread chart can be, for example, the price of the first contract minus the price of the second contract. In the example below are two contracts: ES and SP with the multipliers: 1 and -1.

The price for the Spread Chart is computed using the formula:

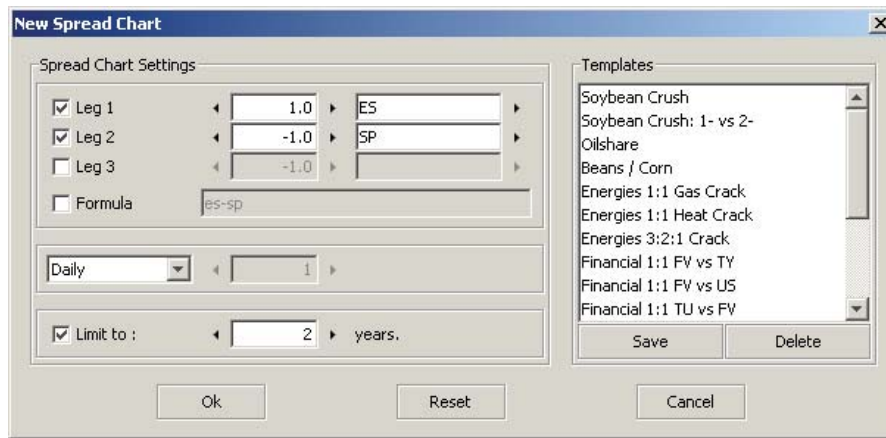
**Spread Chart = a \* X + b \* Y** where: a = the multiplier for the first contract (1). b = the multiplier for the second contract (-1). X = the close price for the first contract (ES). Y = the close price for the second contract (SP).

## Creating a new spread chart



### Spread Chart Settings

The spread chart in the figure is composed from two contracts: ES and SP with the factors: +1 and -1. The spread chart is calculated using formula:  $1*ES - 1*SP$ . You can choose the contracts and the factors (as is shown in the figure) or you can write the formula - is the same thing.

The formula may contain operators: “+”, “-”, “\*”, “/”, parenthesis: “(”, “)”, variables as: “EC”, “ECU03” or “EC1-” and any float number. The values as “2.4651E+1” are **NOT** accepted. Some examples of formulas:

ES - 2.5\*SP

ESU05 - (2\*SPU05 + ECU05 - ECM05)

ES1- - 2\*SP1-

The advantage of using formula is that you can use unlimited number of contracts in your formula. If you don't use formula you are limited at three contracts.

### Templates

You can save the formula that you are using for a spread chart (from “Save” button) in a template and use this template any time you need it. If you no more need a template you can delete it. To delete a template, first you have to select it and then press “Delete” button.

# Point and Figure Charts

## Point and figure chart

The point and figure chart graphs an issue's significant up and down trends over a specified period of time. The **box size** tells how great the change in price must be to be significant and the **reversal** shows the number of boxes required to change the trend. Each X indicates that the price has increased with the value of one box (with one box size); each O indicates that price has decreased with the value of one box.



A column of X's represent an up trend and a column of O's represent a down trend. The P&F Charts are used to identify support levels, resistance levels and chart patterns. The charts ignore the time factor and concentrate only on movements in price - up trends and down trends represented by columns of X's and O's.

## Quote Monitor

The Quote Monitor shows the quotes and their evolution in time. You can have one or more tables with quotes. Each table can contain many rows, but must contain at least one row. Every row contains data for a specified contract (ECY, ECZ05, ... or other). Every row is receiving real time contract updates. When an update comes, the cell is highlighted. For example, in the picture below the “Last” amount for ESU05 has changed, so the cell is highlighted in blue.

## Quote Monitor Features

### Drag-and-drop

There is drag-and-drop at column level. You can change the order of columns in a table, simply by drag-and-drop. Drag-and-drop at row level allows you to change the order of the rows in a table.

### Row types

There are three types of rows:

*Empty rows:* You can change an empty row into a quote row by writing the name of the contract in the contract cell. You can also use empty rows for some delimitations in the table.

*Titled rows:* On a title row you can write the name of an exchange, for example, for a group of rows.

*Quote rows:* These are rows that contain information about a quote and receives real time quote updates.

**Contract**

The “Contract” column contains a list of contracts. For example ECM05 means Euro FX (Composite) for June 2005. You can edit a cell by double clicking on that cell. Then you can write the name of a contract that you want to see and press <Enter>. This row will listen now for online updates for the contract you typed.

**Last**

The price of the last trade (or settlement if the market has already been closed and the settlement price has come in). In the graphic, prices containing S at the end (S from settlement) show that the market is closed.

The variation of the current price (last/trade) related to the previous settlement. It can be either positive or negative, based on the market trend. Any cells marked “N/A” indicate that the information is not available.

## Quote Monitor Columns (Cont'd)

### Bid / Ask

#### Bid

The price that a market participant is prepared to pay at a particular time to buy a commodity.

#### Ask

The price that a market participant is prepared to pay at a particular time to sell a commodity.

When a new contract is trading, the bid and ask cells will be highlighted. In this picture, ECZ05 and ESU05 are trading. For ECZ05, bid starts from 1.23300 and ask from 1.23340. Buyers and sellers will negotiate until bid and ask reach the same value. When this occurs the trading will take place.

### Tick

The evolution of the current trading session displayed as a trade-to-trade variation with pluses and minuses (or equal signs) based on the up or down trend of the market. Starting with version v1.2.5 the pluses, minuses and equal signs are substituted with colors:

The color of NC positive (green in the picture) for pluses

The color of NC negative (red in the picture) for minuses

The color of text (black in the picture) for equal

### Open

#### Opening

The period at the beginning of the trading session officially designated by the exchange during which all transactions are considered made "at the opening."

#### Opening Price

The price recorded during the period designated by the exchange as the official opening.

Depth Of Market is easy to use: type a contract in the “Contract” field and hit **<Enter>**. You can also choose a contract from [Contract Lookup](#) dialog. To open Contract Lookup dialog press the right arrow button from the right side of “Contract” field.

# Contract Lookup

## Contract Lookup Dialog

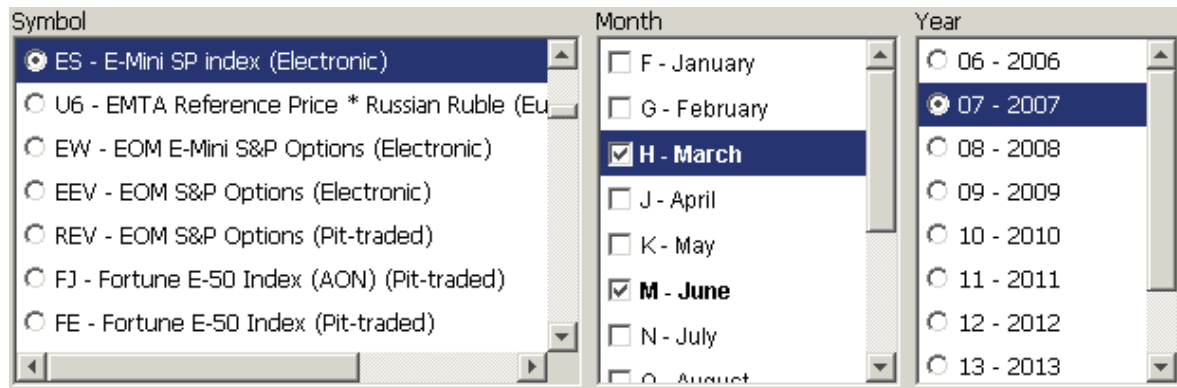
The Contract Lookup Dialog is used to get a contract or a list of contracts and use them in a module.

**Exchanges / Categories bar** From “Exchanges / Categories” bar you can choose an exchange or a category. To see categories press “Categories” button; to see exchanges press the “Exchanges” button - the buttons will switch. In the figure the “Exchanges” button is active, this means that the exchanges are visible. If you select an exchange or category, the symbols for that exchange or category will be loaded in the list of symbols called “Symbol”.



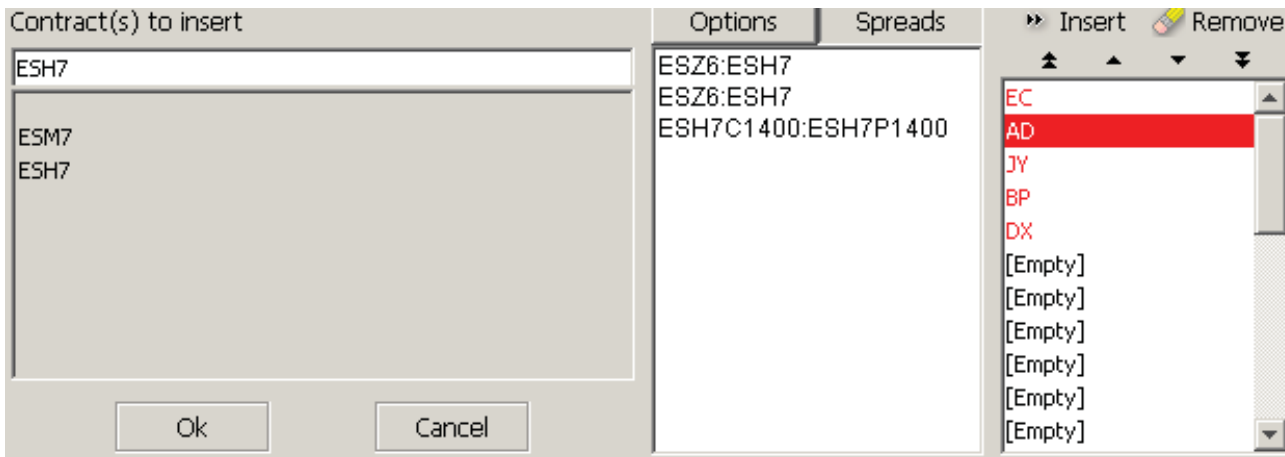
## Choose contract(s)



After you have chosen an exchange or category you have a symbol list. Now, you can select *one contract* or *multiple contracts* depending on the module you are in. In some modules you work with one contract, in others you can have many contracts. If you are in a module that works with only *one contract*, then select a symbol, a month, a year and then press “Ok”.





## Contract Lookup (Cont'd)

If you are in a module that works with *multiple contracts* you have to select a symbol or a list of symbols, then you select a month or a list of months and then you select the year. You are not allowed to select more than one month if you have selected a list of symbols; the same for symbols: you are not allowed to select more than one symbol if you have selected a list of months. You cannot have many symbols and many months at the same time.



In the example (see the screen on the previous page) I selected the symbol “ES - E-Mini SP index (Electronic)” with two months: March and June for 2007. If none of the “Options” or “Spreads” buttons are toggled, and you press the **Insert**  button, the selected contracts from the left side will be added in the list of the selected contracts (both: ESM7 and ESH7). If the “Options” button is toggled, the options contracts for the selected contract will be loaded in the list below the “Options” and “Spreads” buttons; if you press the **Insert**  button, the selected options contract(s) will be added in the list of selected contracts.

If the “Spreads” button is toggled, the spread contracts for selected contract will be loaded in the list below the “Options” and “Spreads” buttons; if you press the **Insert**  button, the selected spread contract(s) will be added in the list of selected contracts.

To delete contracts from the list of selected contracts, select the contracts you want to delete and then press the **Remove**  button.

If you agree with the selected contract (s) click “Ok”.

## Snapshot Quote

### Snapshot Quote


Snapshot Quote shows the last values for a given contract without making any future updates. If you want the snapshot to update its data, click on the contract field and press <Enter>. The snapshot will load the current values for the contract that you specified. The updates in a snapshot can be made manually only; each time you want it. In a snapshot, you can watch only one contract at a time.

# Ticker

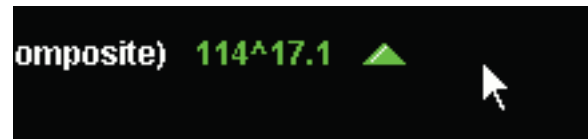
One, two or more contracts can be added into a ticker. Ticker will listen for new updates for every contract. If the information is not available, the field will be set as N/A.



## Direction

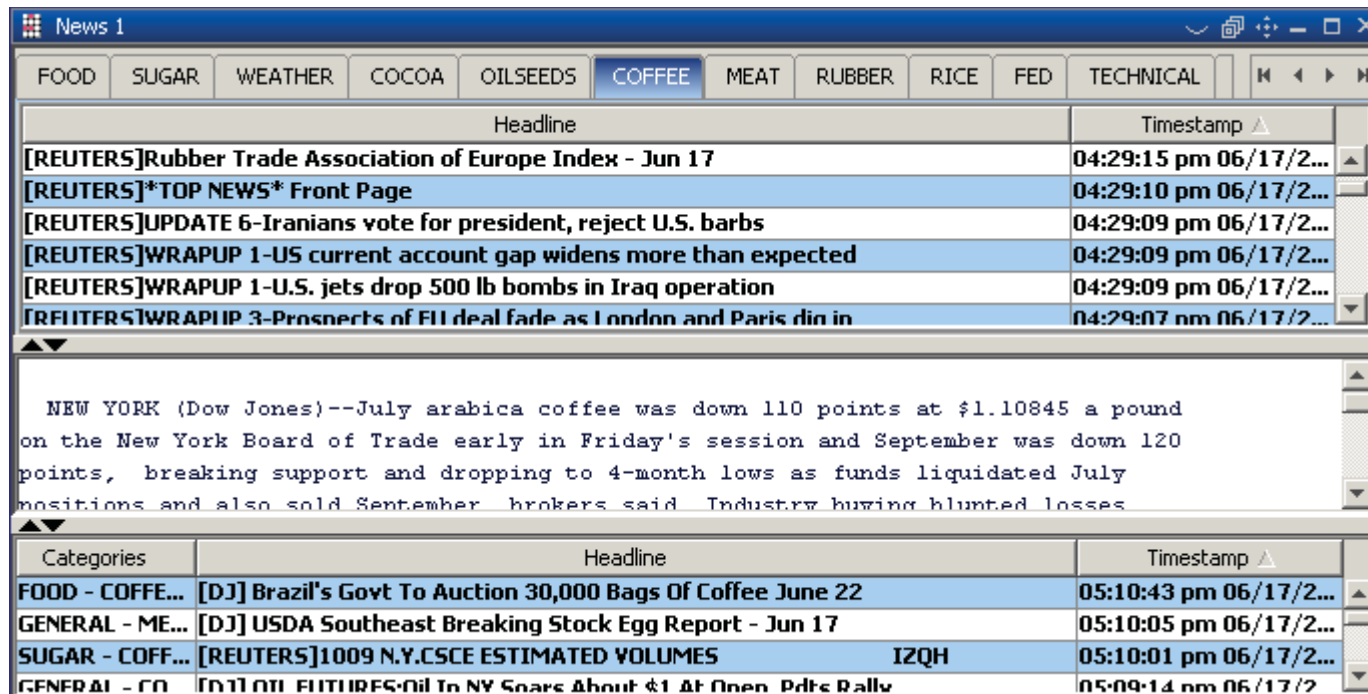
From the two buttons from the left you can change the speed and direction of ticker. To increase speed to the left press (◀◀) button; to increase speed to the right press (▶▶) button.

**Drag-and-drop** You can use drag-and-drop to change the direction of ticker.



In the news module there are three sections:

- 1.) In the top of the news frame is all news grouped by categories. Every category is in a new tab. In the figure below are shown the following categories: ANALYSIS, COCOA, COFFEE, COMMENTS, CURRENCY, ECONOMY and WEATHER. The news is decreasingly ordered by time - with the most recent at the top. The order can be changed by single clicking on the table header named "Timestamp". The arrow from the header will change it's direction according to the order of the news (up arrow (▲) if the news is decreasingly ordered by time; down arrow (▼) if the news is increasingly ordered by time).
- 2.) The second section - in the center of the news frame - contains the content of the selected news.
- 3.) The third section - in the bottom of the news frame - contains a list of all the news, the same news that is in the first section, but this is not grouped by categories on different tabs. These are also ordered by time - the last ones are in the top.



Single click on a news will show the content of that news (in the second section). Double click on a news will open the content of that news in a new dialog.

## Advanced Options

In the Option frame are shown the **futures** and the **options** for a given contract. Basically the Options frame consists of 2 tables:

Futures table - contains informations related to the future contract;

Options tables - contains informations relates to the option contracts for a given future contract.

Besides these tables the Options frame contains:

- One bar between the futures table and the options table with the **P/L**, the **Delta** and the **Gamma**;
- One bar at the bottom of the frame with the **Rate of interest**, and two check boxes, **Show Calls** and **Show Puts** to show/hide the calls and the puts tables.

The Options tables are organized in tabs corresponding to the contract months. An options table is made up of 3 sub-tables:

*Calls table* - contains the informations related to the calls;

*Strikes table* - is a symmetrical table, it contains the strikes column in the centre and the calls columns on the left side and the puts columns on the right side;

*Puts table* - contains the informations related to the puts.


- ⏴ "go to bottom" - this will go to the bottom of the table;

- ⏴ "go to top" - this will go to the top of the table.

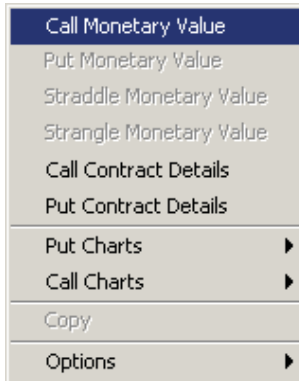

## Popup Menu

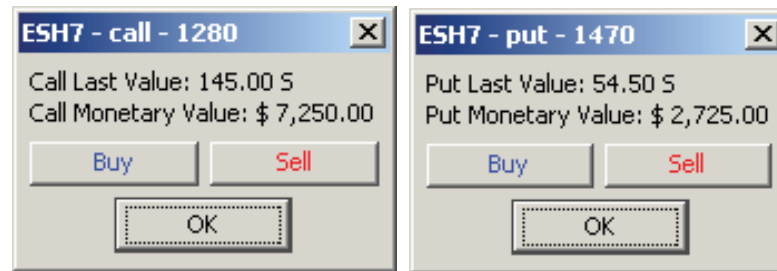


*Put/Call Charts* - This item will trigger a chart for the selected option contract.

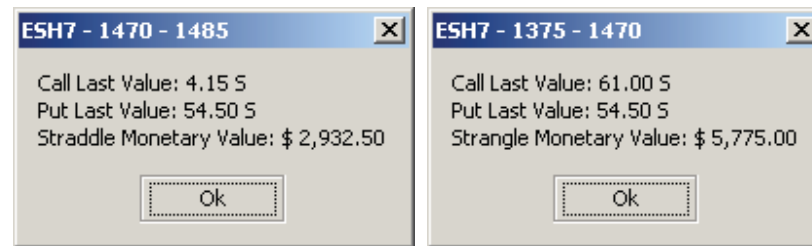
*Copy* - copies into the clipboard the selected cells. They can be pasted in Excel.

*Options* - Contains all the items from the toolbar.

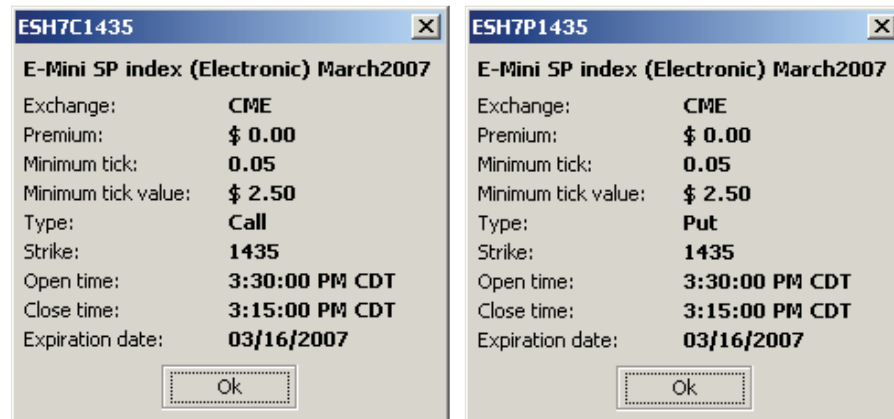
*The Call/Put Monetary value* - this item triggers a dialog that contains the monetary value and two buttons to place orders.



*Straddle/Strangle Monetary value* - this item triggers a dialog that contains the straddle/strangle of two option contracts.




*Call/Put Contract Details* - this item triggers a dialog that contains the contract details.



## Working Order Monitor

Working Order Monitor allows you to see all your orders that are waiting to be accepted, cancelled, etc. It also allows you to sort or filter the orders the way you want.


### Sorting and grouping

The Working Order Monitor table can be sorted as you wish. Clicking on a column header will sort the data in the table in ascending or alphabetical order, depending on the type of the column. Clicking again on the same header will sort the data in descending / reverse alphabetical order. A small arrow will appear to show how the data is sorted.

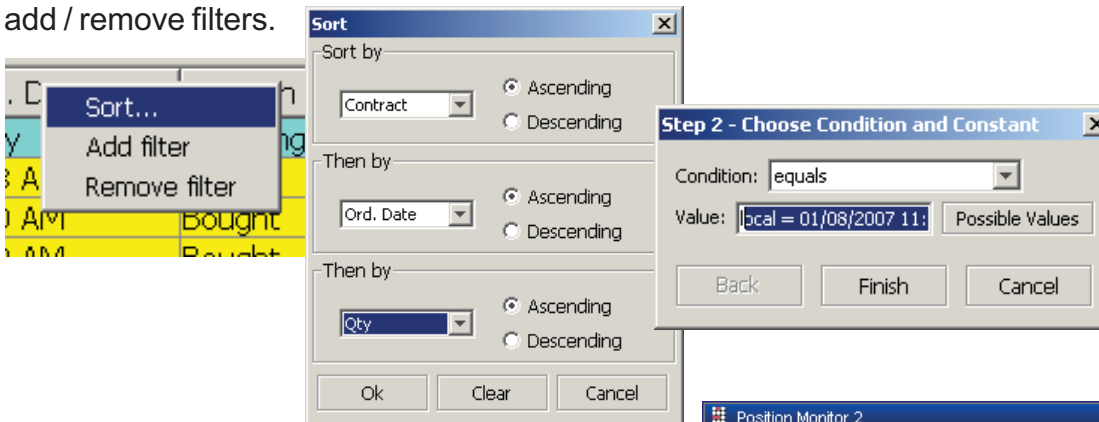

## Position Monitor (Cont'd)

If data is sorted by profit, the positions are divided in three groups. The net positions of each of the three groups are shown in different configurable colors. The limits of these groups as well as their colors can be defined in the preferences dialog. If some of the positions are not on screen, use the scroll bar on the right of each group to browse.

Check the “Show Net Positions” option to sort inside a net position.

Notice that the sorting is done in each group.

## Order Ticket

This is the form that allows the user to place orders. Orders can be placed by editing the required fields. The “Quick Entry” bar can be used to edit the fields. To place an order using the “Quick Entry” bar, simply type the account , B or S (Buy or Sell), the quantity, the contract symbol, the strike value, the price and type of the order. While typing you will see that after you have typed one of those elements, it will be bolded in the tooltip below.



## Order Ticket (Cont'd)

## Order Activity Log

In this frame, the application displays all the information about the orders entered during a session. It displays the fills, the new fills, the cancelled orders. Other displayed data includes account, status, side, quantity, contract name, price, lifetime.



## Quote Board

Quote Board shows the quotes and their evolution in time. You can have one or more pages with quotes. Every cell contains data for a specified contract (ECY, ECZ5, ... or other). Every cell is updating. For positive net change the text color is green, for negative net change it is red; if there is no net change the text color is black. You can change these colors from properties.

The description of each item in a non-empty cell:

- contract name
- O - **O**pening Price (or opening range depends of what is set in the properties);
- H - **H**igh;
- L - **L**ow;
- T - **T**ast Trade;
- *delta* - Net Change.

Price Ladder is easy to use: write a contract in the “Contract” field and type **<Enter>**. You can also choose a contract from Contract Lookup dialog - is the same thing. If you want to open Contract Lookup dialog press the  button from the right side of “Contract” field.

## Options Chain

In the Option Chain frame are shown the **futures** and the **options** for a given contract. Basically the Options Chain frame consists of 2 tables:

Futures table - contains informations related to the future contract;

Options tables - contains informations relates to the option contracts for a given future contract.

The Options tables are organized in tabs corresponding to the contract months. An options table is simetrical, with Calls on the left side and Puts on the right side. The Strike column is in the middle and the option contracts are organized by the strike price in ascending order, from top to bottom.

## Time and Sales

In the Time & Sales frame, you can watch only for one contract at a time. As trades are executed, they are reported here. There are four boxes in the top of frame. In the first one you must enter the contract. If you don't know any contract you can choose one using [Contract Lookup](#) dialog.

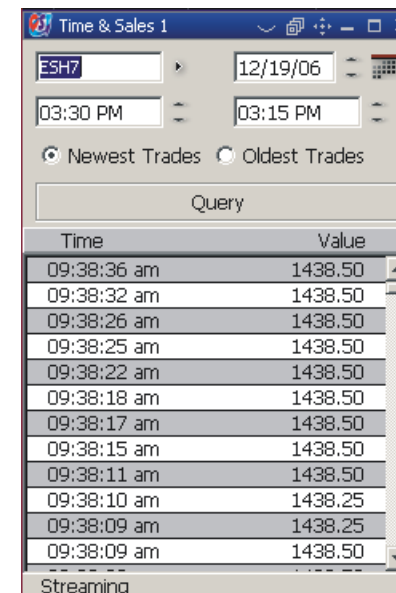
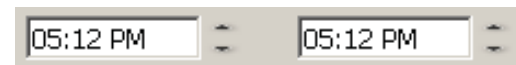
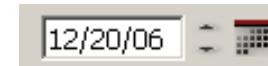
The second box is for date. Type here the date for which you want to get the information. You can use the Date Picker for more information .

The last ones are for the time range.

A new Time & Sales frame:

After you have chosen a contract you must click on the “Query” button to get the data. At the bottom of the frame is text which, according with the state of the contract, can be “Streaming” or “Static.” By double clicking a column you can highlight a certain price, visualizing the high and low prices in different colors.

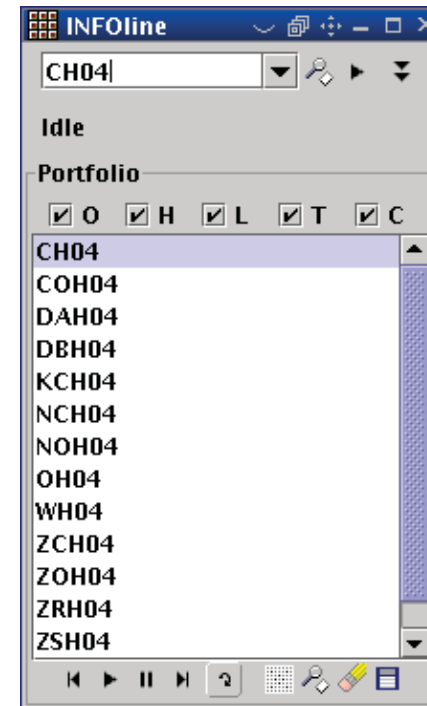
The layout of your table can be horizontal or vertical as you wish.



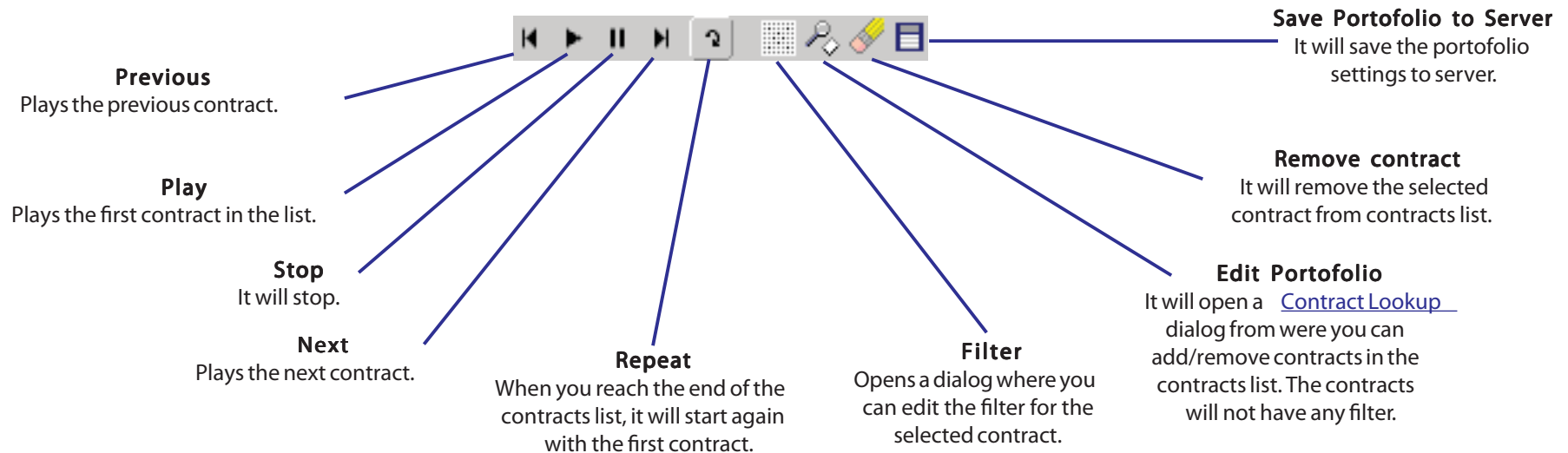
Here you can listen to prices for a contract or for a list of contracts. You can't have more than one INFOline frame at a time. In the top of the frame you can write a contract in the contract field or choose a contract using [Contract Lookup](#) dialog. You can listen to the prices for that contract by single clicking on the play button. The prices will be those selected in the top of the Portofolio section. "O" = open, "H" = high, "L" = low, "T" = last and "C" = net change. The last button from the top is used to add the contract in the contracts list.



Every contract has a filter for the prices that will be songed. If you don't choose any filter for a contract, the filter from the top of the portofolio will be choosed by default.



In the button of the portofolio section there are a group of buttons.



## Tools - Alarms

### Alarms dialog

The Alarms dialog includes a table with the current registered alarms; This table consists of 8 columns that describe the properties of every alarm:

**Contract** - the alarm is registered for a contract name;

**Time** - the hour when the alarm will be activated;

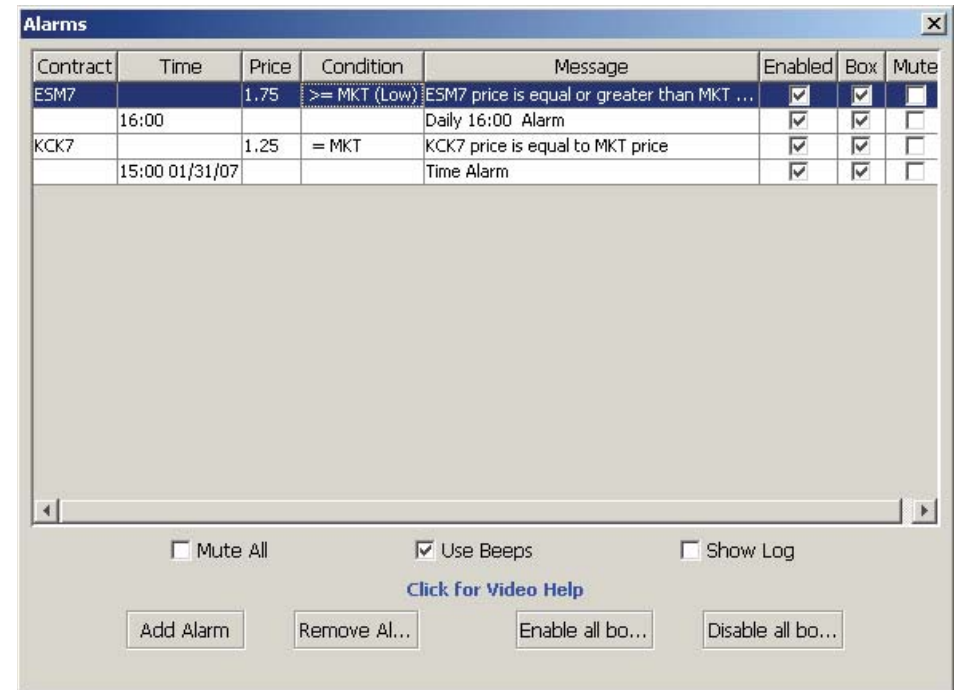
**Price** - the price for comparison which will trigger the alarm;

**Condition** - the condition for comparison; it's result triggers the alarm;

**Message** - The text displayed in the alarm's notification window;

**Enabled** - enable or disable the selected alarm;

**Box** - enable or disable the alarm's notification window.



**Mute** - enable or disable the playing of the sound associated with the selected alarm.

To add a new alarm, press the **Add alarm** button. To remove an alarm, press the **Remove alarm** button.

Each row contains an alarm. The alarm is triggered **if and only if** the **Enabled** checkbox is selected. If **Box** checkbox is selected, a notification pop-up window will appear on the screen and will notify the user, displaying the **Message** set for the alarm. If the **Mute** checkbox is not selected, the associated sound for the alarm will be heard by the user when the notification window appears. If you don't like alarm notification windows, use **Disable all boxes** button. Use **Enable all boxes** button to enable all notification windows.

Check **Mute All** checkbox to disable all alarm sounds. Check **Use Beeps** to hear a *beep* sound when the alarm is triggered.

### Add an alarm

There are two types of alarms that can be set up: **price alarms** and **time alarms**.

**Price Alarms.** If the last price for the selected contract has reached the price value set for the alarm or is in the range described by the condition set for the alarm, the alarm will be triggered. You can write the contract by typing or choose it from Contract Lookup Dialog by single click on the button from the right of contract field. Then, enter the value of the price for the alarm. Use the additional checkboxes to customize the alarm's condition.

**Time Alarms.** A time alarm is set to be triggered at a specified moment in time. A time alarm can also be triggered daily.

## Alarms (Cont'd)

### Notification pop-up windows

Every time an alarm is invoked - if **Enable alarm boxes** option is selected - on the screen will appear a dialog that will look like the one from the right side.

A new pop-up window will be shown on the screen for every new alarm update. To disable this kind of messages select **Disable box** and then press **Close** button or deselect all boxes Alarms dialog.




### Alarms log

By single click on the “Show Log” box from alarms dialog a new dialog with alarms log will appear.

The alarms are ordered by timestamp. The timestamp is the time value when the last alarm was invoked for a given contract.

By pressing the “Clear Table” button the log will be deleted.

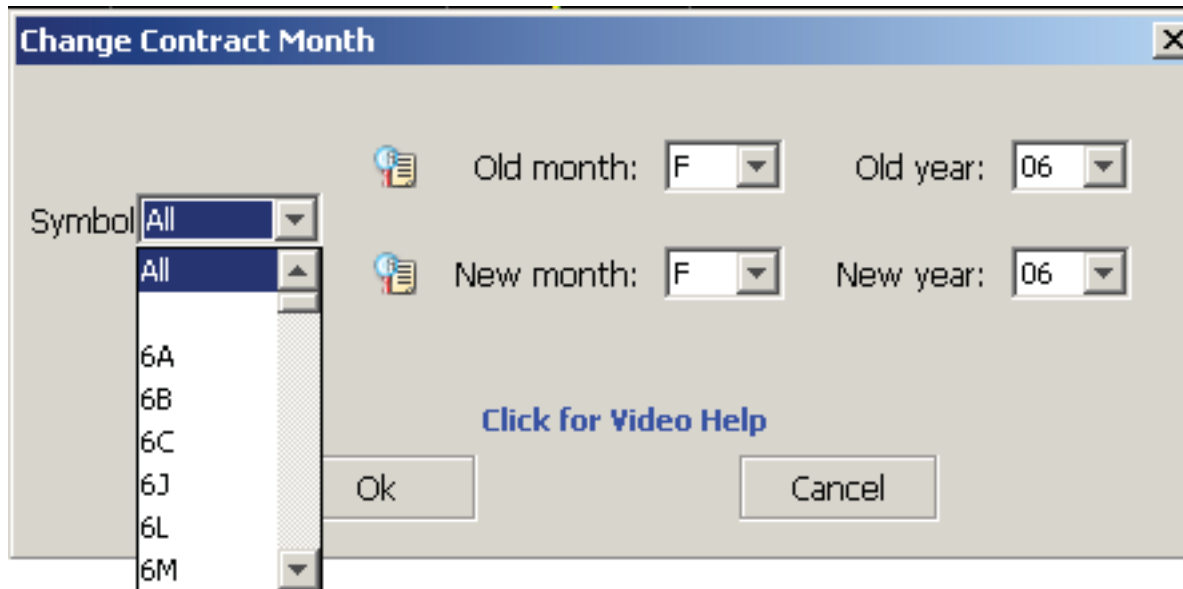

## Change Contract Month

---

This will change the contract month in the entire application. For example, if the old contract month was U (September) and the new one is Z (December), use this feature to easily make the changes in the whole application. In this example the U month will be replaced with Z.

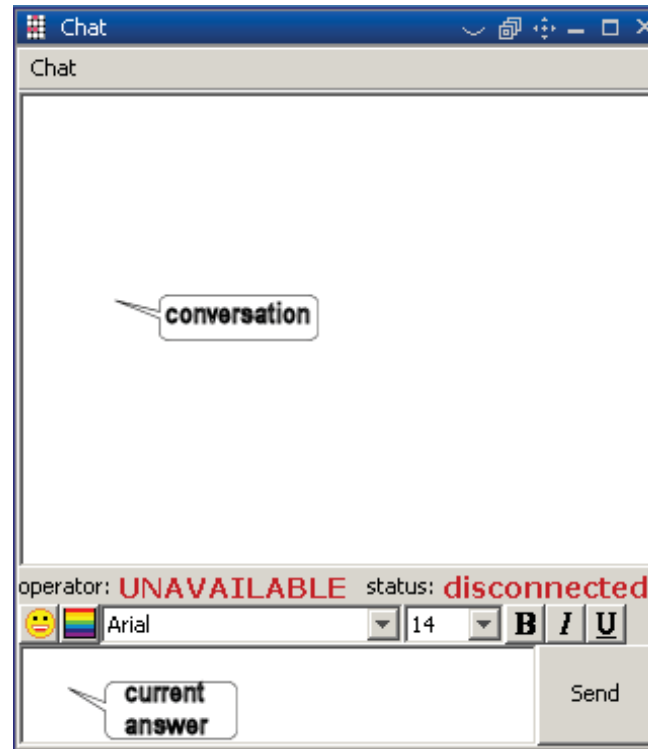


You can apply the changes for all the symbols - by choosing *All* - or just for one symbol by choosing the symbol.

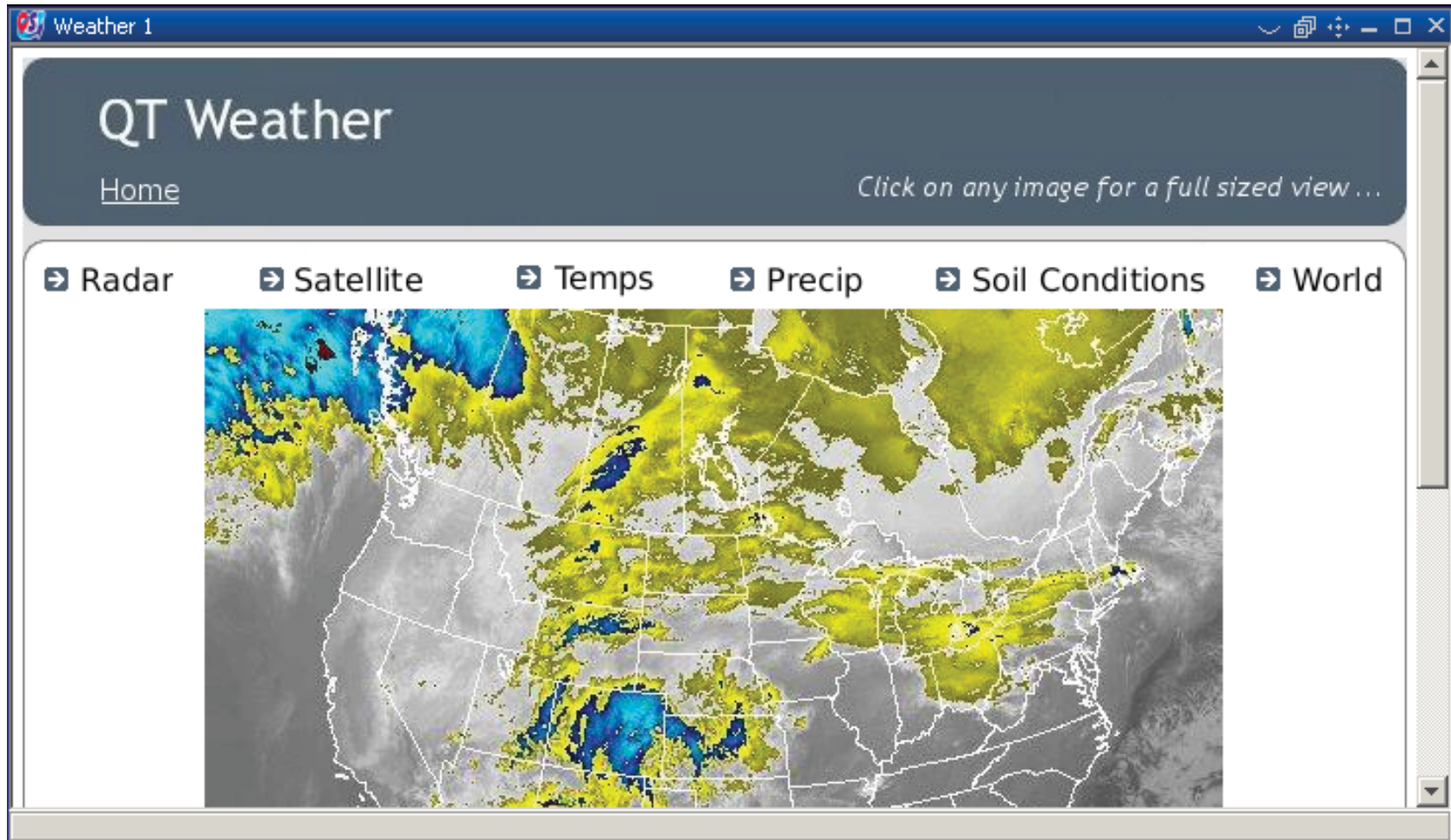


